Started insurance consultation service with insurance planners on LINE, utilizing LINE Business Connect for the first time in Life insurance industry

TOKYO, August 5, 2016 – LIFENET INSURANCE COMPANY (TSE Mothers 7157, President Daisuke Iwase, URL: http://ir.lifenet-seimei.co.jp/en/) announces the monthly business performance for July 2016.

Annualized premium^{*1} of new business in the month of July 2016 was 101 million yen (112% of July 2015). The number of applications was 2,824 (116% of July 2015), with the number of new business at 2,150 (114% of July 2015). Accordingly, annualized premium^{*1} of policies-in-force was 9,603 million yen. The number of policies-in-force as of the end of July 2016 resulted in a total of 229,792, and sum insured of policies-in-force stands at 1,929,161 million yen.

In July 2016, insurance premiums and claims and benefits recorded 790 million yen (107% of July 2015) and 81 million yen (79% of July 2015), respectively.

Lifenet started insurance consultation service from July 11 with insurance planners on LINE, utilizing LINE Business Connect for the first time in Life insurance industry. ² That enables our customers to consult the insurance planners with more convenience by choosing from three ways; call, email and LINE.
