Annualized premium of new business was 108 million yen, 103% of October 2015

TOKYO, November 8, 2016 – LIFENET INSURANCE COMPANY (TSE Mothers 7157, President Daisuke Iwase, URL: http://ir.lifenet-seimei.co.jp/en/) announces the monthly business performance for October 2016.

Annualized premium^{*1} of new business in the month of October 2016 was 108 million yen (103% of October 2015). The number of applications was 3,121 (108% of October 2015), with the number of new business at 2,324 (106% of October 2015). Accordingly, annualized premium^{*1} of policies-in-force was 9,749 million yen. The number of policies-in-force as of the end of October 2016 resulted in a total of 232,654, and sum insured of policies-in-force stands at 1,940,986 million yen.

In October 2016, insurance premiums and claims and benefits recorded 803 million yen (107% of October 2015) and 114 million yen (159% of October 2015), respectively.
