Annualized premium of new business was 118 million yen, 125% of January 2016

TOKYO, February 7, 2017 – LIFENET INSURANCE COMPANY (TSE Mothers 7157, President Daisuke Iwase, URL: http://ir.lifenet-seimei.co.jp/en/) announces the monthly business performance for January 2017.

Annualized premium^{*1} of new business in the month of January 2017 was 118 million yen (125% of January 2016). The number of applications was 4,052 (126% of January 2016), with the number of new business at 2,622 (125% of January 2016). Accordingly, annualized premium^{*1} of policies-in-force was 9,916 million yen. The number of policies-in-force as of the end of January 2017 resulted in a total of 236,057, and sum insured of policies-in-force stands at 1,952,534 million yen.

In January 2017, insurance premiums and claims and benefits recorded 815 million yen (107% of January 2016) and 80 million yen (81% of January 2016), respectively.
